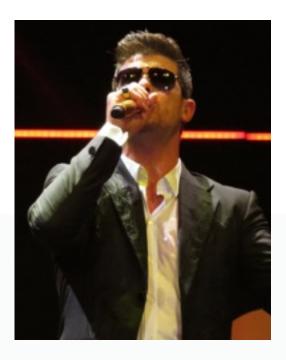

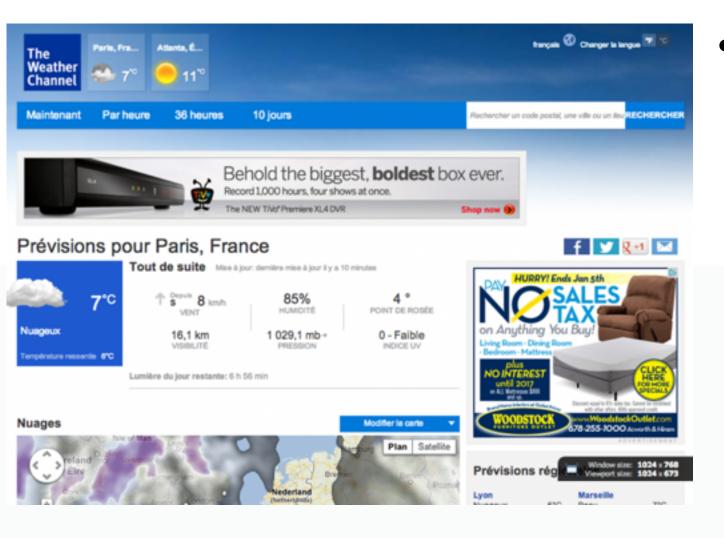

- Exposure to new things

- More skilled team

Business investment



- Investment in future
- Minimum investment: 10%

- Help other people

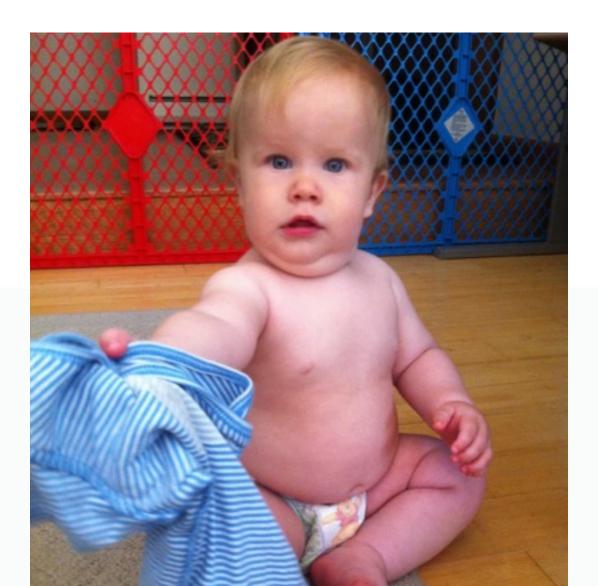

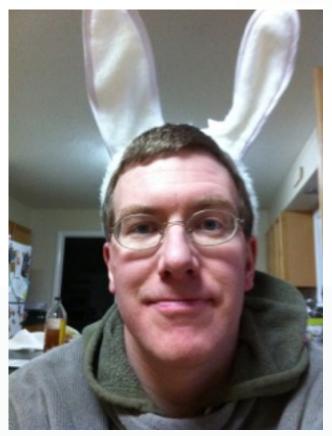

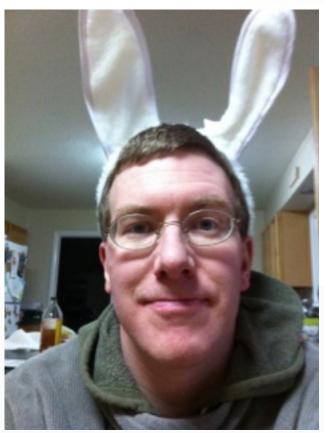
